PROMOTING GROWTH AND ENRICHMENT

Our person-centered services promote growth, enrichment, and a meaningful day for over 300 adults with developmental disabilities. Daytime activities are offered at four sites in DuPage County. Being an active member in the community is a focus for daily activities in our Community Learning Centers.

At each site, people we support participate in a wide variety of in-house and community activities that include socialization, health and wellness, safety, and independent living skills. Each Community Learning Center provides people the opportunity to give back to their communities through volunteering, partnerships, and participation in the life of the community. Community Learning Center's programs and activities are driven by what people want, despite their ability level. All Team members meet the unique needs of those that attend programming to have a great day every day.

For many who choose to secure employment, we work closely with our Employment Services Team to offer customized assessments and focus on skills needed to prepare for a job interview and to obtain and maintain employment.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Where are the CLCs located?

Lombard, Lisle, Elmhurst, and Burr Ridge.

Is transportation provided?

Transportation services are offered based on availability, generally from your home to the closest CLC.

How do you pay for services?

Families can use their Home-based Services or Day Programming funding. Private pay options are also available for families in need.

What are the service hours?

M-F from 9:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Full-time attendance is expected, but part-time is an option with a customized schedule possibility.
